As a convenience to coaches and athletes, we will provide coaches with our appointment schedule to allow an easy sign-up process. If athletes miss the sign-up with their team/coaches, they should make appointments in the Student-Athlete Resource Center – Lassen 3002.

Only students who appear on the Athletic Academic Team rosters are allowed to use our advising services during the above weeks and only these students are eligible for priority. NO EXCEPTIONS. Continuing student-athletes who do not attend their advising appointment will lose priority registration in an upcoming semester. Waiting until drop-in advising times does not fulfill the advising requirement.

Graduating senior student-athletes or those finishing their last season of eligibility are expected to see us for APR and/or graduation questions; however they are not required to attend a mandatory session. These students are also welcome to come in during our drop-in period after April 19th.
